BENNETT EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 75-5

APPOINTMENTS AND DESIGNATIONS

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 75-107 the Governor is directed and authorized to transact all the business of the state with the federal government and its various agencies, which, from time to time, require appointment and designation of state officials and agencies as program coordinators, program administrating agencies, program directors, and certifying officials, among others; and

WHEREAS, the following appointments and designations are appropriate and necessary in order to conduct the orderly business of state in cooperation and compliance with the federal programs affecting state business as are set out herein, to-wit:

FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING

WHEREAS, the requirements of the federal "State and Local Fiscal Assistance Act of 1972", P.L. 92-512, 5 U.S.C. 301, otherwise known as the federal revenue sharing act, in addition to the appointment of Lieutenant Governor Shelby Smith as the federal revenue sharing certifying official under Executive Order No. 75-2, require the designation of a State Coordinator

to assist the federal office of revenue sharing to contact, communicate with and assist recipients of revenue sharing funds, and such designation is deemed to be appropriate and necessary;

1975 NATIONAL UNITED NATIONS DAY

WHEREAS, the national chairman of the National United Nations Day observance has requested the Governor to appoint a state United Nations Day chairman to coordinate planning and preparation for the 1975 observance of United Nations Day, and such appointment is deemed to be appropriate and necessary;

FOREIGN DISASTER RELIEF

WHEREAS, the federal Foreign Disaster Relief Coordinator has requested the Governor of this and other states to consider the appointment of permanent state foreign disaster relief coordinators with whom the federal Agency for International Development of the Department of State could work in the event citizens of this and other states engage in large-scale disaster relief collections, and such appointment is deemed to be appropriate and necessary;

NATIONAL MASS TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the federal "National Mass Transportation Act of 1974", P.L. 93-503, which amends the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, 49 U.S.C. 1603, and in particular Section 5 thereof, provides for the Governor, or his designee, to administer the state program of urban mass transportation with respect to

designating recipients of funds dispensed in accordance with said public laws, and the designation of an agency to coordinate and administer those elements of said public laws that require action by the Governor, or the Governor's designee, is deemed to be appropriate and necessary;

STATE HEALTH SYSTEMS AGENCIES

WHEREAS, the federal "National Health Planning and Resources Development Act of 1974", P.L. 93-641, calls for the establishment of state health planning and development agencies, and local health systems agencies, and requires the Governor to designate boundaries of local health service areas for which these agencies will provide the services, funds and program approval as provided by said public laws, and the designation of a state agency to act as the Governor's designee to carry out the area designation process is deemed to be appropriate and necessary;

TITLE XX OF SOCIAL SERVICES ACT

WHEREAS, the federal "Social Services Amendments of 1974", P.L. 93-647, has added Title XX to the Social Services Act, and provides that the Governor shall designate an appropriate agency which will administer or supervise the administration of the state's program for the provision of the services described in Section 2002(a)(1) of said public law, and the designation of such agency for such purposes is deemed to be appropriate and necessary;

APPOINTMENT AND DESIGNATION

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROBERT F. BENNETT, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF KANSAS, order, appoint and designate the following persons and agencies to perform the duties prescribed by the applicable federal and state laws, rules and regulations, and this Executive Order, for the offices set opposite their names, to-wit:




