BENNETT EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 75-10

WHEREAS, by Executive Order filed with the Secretary of State on July 22, 1974, effective July 1, 1974, Governor Robert B. Docking created and established the Agency Council for the Kansas Capitol Complex Management Program to coordinate the program with agency administrators; and

WHEREAS, the Capitol Complex Management Program is sponsored, operated and funded by and through the University of Kansas for the benefit of state officers and employees with the participation of the state of Kansas under K.S.A. 1974 Supp. 75-5519; and

WHEREAS, the agency council so created is unable to legally adopt rules and regulations to implement K.S.A. 1974 Supp. 75-5519, and is unable to proceed further than deliberative sessions which have produced suggested guidelines to be followed by agencies in determining eligibility of employees for various levels of educational programs under said law; and

WHEREAS, the honorable efforts and deliberations of said council should now be considered by a lawfully created rule-making agency, and the council should be abolished.

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby rescind and repeal the Gubernatorial Executive Order entitled "ESTABLISHMENT OF THE AGENCY COUNCIL FOR THE KANSAS CAPITOL COMPLEX MANAGEMENT PROGRAM", filed July 22, 1974, and, further, hereby abolish the agency council by revoking the ex officio appointments made by said executive order.

FURTHER, by the power vested in me by Article 1, Section 3 of the Kansas Constitution, I order and direct the Secretary of Administration to adopt accounting policies under the authority of K.S.A. 1974 Supp. 75-3706 and K.S.A. 1974 Supp. 75-3707(2), (3), (5) and (12), to adopt rules and regulations governing the application of K.S.A. 1974 Supp. 75-5519.

This document shall be filed with the Secretary of State as Executive Order No. 75-10.
